

ORDER

Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi has decided that henceforth all independent restaurants, which are otherwise eligible for obtaining Excise licenses shall be completely de-barred from hosting functions on P-10 permits.

Further, registration is mandatory for all unlicensed premises, who host the P-10 parties/events, without payment of any registration fee. The registration module would be opened from 29.08.2019 (10.00am onwards) online, on the website delhiexcise.gov.in. In case any excise violation is found on the premises, it may be debarred for atleast three months from applying P-10 permits in the first case. In case of repeat violation, the premises would be debarred for a period of one year. This registration would not be applicable for individual applying P-10 for hosting function at private residential properties and parks or community centres owned and maintained by local municipal bodies/gram sabha/cantonment board etc.


