ORDER

During inspection of Hotel, Clubs and Restaurants in the recent past by the Excise Team, it has been reported that at the Bar counters and sometimes at the designated liquor store, many bottles are found either without the requisite bar-code sticker pasted or have unreadable bar-code. This practice has been viewed very seriously by the Department.

Therefore, all the licensees holding licenses in form of L-15/L-15F, L-16/L-16F, L-17/L-17F, L-18/L-18F, L-19/L-19F, L-21/L-21F, L-28/L-28F and L-29/L-29F are hereby directed to ensure that bar-codes stickers are invariable pasted on the liquor bottles and the same are scan able. They are directed to retain the 2D bar-code on the bottle whether the bottle is in L-17 store or at the bar counter (at the bar counter, 2D bar-code should be pasted with a cello tape at the side of the bottle so as to ensure that the 2D bar-code does not get destroyed while servicing liquor from the bottle by the bar tender)

The absence of 2D bar-code on the bottle will be treated as "NON DUTY PAID LIQUOR" (NDPL) in the licensed premises and necessary action as deemed fit as per Delhi Excise Act,2009 and Delhi Excise Rules,2010 will be initiated against delinquent licensee.

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
