TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF L-7Z/L-7V LICENSE FOR THE YEAR 2021-22

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENSE IN FORM L-7Z (ZONAL LICENSE FOR RETAIL VEND OF INDIAN LIQUOR AND FOREIGN LIQUOR) AND L-7V (RETAIL VEND OF INDIAN LIQUOR, FOREIGN LIQUOR IN A ZONE) FOR THE EXCISE YEAR 2021-22 FOR THE RETAIL SALE OF INDIAN AND FOREIGN LIQUOR EXCLUDING COUNTRY LIQUOR IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL TERRITORY OF DELHI FOR THE LICENSING PERIOD 2021-2022.

Zonal License in Form L-7Z of Indian Liquor, Foreign Liquor & in Form L-7V for retail vend of Indian Liquor, Foreign Liquor in a Zone, in the National Capital Territory of Delhi shall be granted by the Government for the year 2021-2022 in accordance with the following terms and conditions: -

1. LICENSE FEE

1.1 Each zone shall be granted license in the form of L-7Z through e-tender process and shall pay the license fee as determined through e-tender. This is further subject to earnest money deposit (EMD) and security deposit as prescribed in the e-tender documents.

1.2 The license fees for the first year will only be charged on a pro-rata basis from the scheduled date of commencement of business to the end of the fiscal year 2021-2022. For illustration, if there are 9 operative months left in the fiscal year after the scheduled date of commencement of business, the license fees will be payable only for 9 months calculated on pro-rata basis.

1.3 The license fee of each zone shall be paid by the licensee in accordance with the provisions of Rule 48, wherein a licensee shall, by the 7th of the month in which he begins his business under his license and thereafter by the 7th of every subsequent month, pay in advance one-twelfth of the annual license fee till the whole fee is paid. The 25% security deposited by the licensee shall be adjusted at close of the year. He may, however, at any time, pay the whole amount due if he so wishes.

1.4 If a licensee defaults in paying the monthly advance license fee, either partially or fully, then he shall be liable to pay, on the sum due, a simple interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date next following the day on which such payment became due. Further, if the default continues beyond the 15th day of the month, then an additional penalty at the rate of 0.1% per day on the sum due till the date of actual payment shall be levied. Further, if the licensee fails to pay all the dues (including interest and penalty) by the last day of the month then security deposit shall be forfeited and the license shall be cancelled and re-tendered. The licensee will also be blacklisted and prohibited from participating in any other tendering process for a period of two years

1.5 License fee shall be for the entire zone in Form L-7Z. License in Form L-7V is only a sub-license of L-7Z and accordingly, the successful bidder of the zone i.e. L-7Z licensee shall have to pay the pro-rata monthly fee for a zone as a whole, even if for any reason he chooses to set up less than the prescribed number of vends in form of L-7V in his zone.

1.6 The license fee may be increased on an annual basis to be determined by the Government every year.

2. ELIGIBILITY TO HOLD LICENSE

2.1 Any private legal entity or individual who has proof of filing Income Tax Returns for the last three assessment years is eligible to participate in the bid.

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- 2.2 The eligibility to participate in the tender for retail vends shall also have net worth criteria of at least Rs.6 crore, if the entity intends to participate in tender for one zone and net worth of at least Rs.12 crore, if the entity applies for more than one zone.
- 2.3 No entity will be allocated more than two zones.
- 2.4 The carpet area of the retail vend holding license in form L-7V should not be less than 500 sq. feet (An exception with the approval of the Government could be made only for vends in non-conforming areas) and not more than 2000 Sq Feet.
- 2.5 The proposed L-7V retail vend in a zone should not be located within 100 (One Hundred only) meters from the following:-
- a. Major Educational Institutions (Middle and Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges and other Institutions of higher learning, recognized by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi or Govt. of India).
 - b. Religious Places having pucca structure with a covered area of more than 400 (Four Hundred only)sq. ft.
 - c. Hospitals with fifty beds and above.
- 2.6 No manufacturer or L-1 license holder will be allowed to bid for zonal license of retail vend or vice versa. If retailers and manufacturers/wholesalers are common entities, there is possibility of formation of syndicates leading to overcharging and brand influencing/pushing by entering into exclusivity arrangements with certain brands at the cost of exclusion of others The retail license holder shall not have any manufacturing facilities/distilleries/breweries/wineries anywhere in the country or abroad either directly or through any sister concerns/related entities. For this purpose, sister concerns/related entities shall mean that the entities should not have common proprietor or partners or directors. Majority ownership (51% or more) of the proprietorship or partnership or company shall not lie with the same person in all the entities. The entities shall not have a holding-subsidary relationship or are not subsidiaries of the same holding company."
- 2.7 The entity to participate in the tender for retail license/ vends should have net worth of at least Rs.6 crore, if the entity intends to participate in tender for one zone and net worth of at least Rs.12 crore, if the entity intends to participate in tender for more than one zone

3. HOURS OF SALE AND DRY DAYS

- 3.1 Sale of Indian liquor and foreign liquor shall be allowed between 10.00 A.M and 10.00 P.M. only. However, vends located at the airport shall be allowed to operate round the clock.
- 3.2 The Government shall declare any day as dry day in accordance with Rule 52 of the Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 which maybe at par with the neighboring States. The L-7Z Licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation or relief due to any increase in the number of Dry Days or due to change in the hours of sale of Indian and Foreign liquor in the retail vend in the form of L-7V during the licensing year 2021-22.

4. DISTRIBUTION OF RETAIL VENDS IN DELHI:

- 4.1 (i) The 272 wards in 68 Assembly Constituencies are divided into 30 zones. Each zone shall have 9-10 wards and shall be allowed to have a maximum of 27 retail vends (L-7V), having on average 3 retail vends in each ward. However, each zone operator (L-7Z licensee) will have to operate 2 'mandatory vends' in each ward allocated in the zone and the remaining vends will be 'freehold vends' that can be operated anywhere within that zone.

(ii) The New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) Area and Delhi Cantt. Assembly Constituencies do not have Wards and 29 vends shall be allocated for New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) Area and Delhi Cantt. Assembly Constituencies together.

(iii) There shall be 10 retail vends at the Indira Gandhi International Airport.

4.2 The distribution of L-7V retail vends in wards shall be as under:

*NOTE: Due to rounding off, 2 Zones will have 10 Wards each while the other 28 will have 9 wards each. However, each zone will have exactly 27 vends.

5. TENDER PROCESS FOR ALLOTMENT OF THE ZONES:

- 5.1 Allotment will be made through e-tender process with the reserve price as the base license fees.
- 5.2 A non-refundable participation fee of Rs.10 lakh per bid is prescribed for each valid bid per zone.
- 5.3 An entity is free to bid for as many zones as it chooses including all the 32 zones.
- 5.4 The bids will be opened in a pre-determined order, e.g. Zone-1, Zone-2..... Zone-32, to be decided and published by the Government before opening of the bids. As and when any particular entity is declared winning bidder for two zones, the said entity's bids for the remaining zones will be considered invalid and will not be opened.
- 5.5 If any applicant wishes to participate in the bid for only one zone then he shall submit an EMD of Rs.30 crore. If he wants to participate in more than one zone, he shall submit EMD of Rs.60 crore. This EMD will be refunded if the applicant does not win the bid. If the applicant does not accept the license after winning the bid within the stipulated time frame, the EMD amount shall stand forfeited.
- 5.6 The successful bidder for a zone shall provide a security deposit to match 25% of the winning bid amount within one week of the date of issue of Letter of Offer, after adjusting the initial EMD. If a successful bidder fails to pay the 25% security deposit, the EMD shall stand forfeited. The bidder will also be blacklisted and prohibited from participating in any other bidding process for a period of two years. In case, the security deposit is less than the EMD, then the remaining amount will be adjusted towards the payment of license fee.

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5.7 The winning bidders for L-7Z license will get a time of 90 days from the date of issue of L-7Z license to commence business in all their shops. This scheduled date of commencement will be non-negotiable and if any licensee is unable to start operations (partially or fully) by then, they will still be liable to pay the first installment.

5.8 If the licensee is found being engaged in major malpractices, its entire zone license will be cancelled immediately and re-tendered thereafter.

6. PROCEDURE TO APPLY

6.1 The applicant applying for grant of L-7Z License shall participate in e-tender process by paying anon-refundable participation fee of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only).

6.2 The applicant shall be required to submit the following documents along with the application:-

(a) An Affidavit with regard to qualifications for grant of license as prescribed under Section 13 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009

(b) A copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) along with copies of the Income Tax Returns filed by the applicant for the assessment years 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21.

6.3 The information as required for this purpose in the application form shall be furnished with complete details truly and faithfully as to enable processing the applications for grant of L-7Z license. The applicants shall not be entitled to any relief for compensation on account of delay in the finalization of case for the grant of L-7Z License.

7. OTHER CONDITIONS OF LICENSE

7.1 After the completion of the tendering process, the L-7Z licensees will be given two weeks' time to submit their inputs regarding the MRP to the Excise Commissioner. The Excise Commissioner will fix MRP for each product after taking into account the inputs from L-7Z and L-7SP1 licensees and the price of the product in the neighbouring States i.e Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab and Rajasthan. The Excise Commissioner will also provide an opportunity of being heard to each L-7Z and L-7SP1 licensee as prescribed in Rule 54. Similar process will be followed at the time of introduction of new brands during the course of the year. The licensee is free to give concession, rebate or discount on the MRP.

7.2 L-7V licensees are eligible for retail sale of Indian liquor and Foreign liquor to individuals and to all license holders of Hotels, Clubs, Restaurants, Permit Holders etc in form of L-15, L-16, L-17, L-19, L-20, L-21, L-28, L-29, L-38, P-10, P-10E and other licenses/permits as permitted by the Excise Commissioner.

7.3 The L-7V Licensee shall procure Indian and Foreign liquor from L-1 Licensee only through ESCIMS.

7.3 Every license shall be granted subject to the conditions that the Licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009, the Rules framed there under, terms and conditions for grant of L-7Z and L-7V License and orders issued by the Excise Commissioner from time to time.

7.4 The retail vends can be opened in any of the markets, malls, commercial roads/areas, local shopping complexes (LSCs) etc. as long as the standard rules and regulations of opening a new vend in Delhi is followed which includes restrictions on opening vends within a specified distance of schools, religious institutions etc.

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- 7.5 Every vend shall provide a walk-in experience and designed accordingly. To illustrate, customers will not be allowed to crowd outside a vend or in the pavement and buy through the counter. Each customer to be given access inside the vend and the entire selection and sale process to be completed within the vend premise. The vends shall have closed glass doors.
- 7.6 Vends will need to be air conditioned and well lit.
- 7.7 Each shop will have CCTV cameras installed inside and outside the shop and the recording shall be maintained minimum for a period of one month.
- 7.8 Adequate security arrangements shall be made by the licensee in and around each vend.
- 7.9 Licensee shall be responsible for maintenance of law and order around their vend. In case the vend causes nuisance in the neighbourhood and any complaint is received by the Government, the license of that particular vend may be cancelled. However, the license fees for the zone will remain the same.
- 7.10 The licensees will have to ensure compliance of all the terms and conditions of the license including the following:
- a. Timely payment of fees
 - b. Ensuring walk-in retail experience
 - c. No major complaints from the nearby community against the shop.
 - d. Neighborhood should not experience any disturbance due to the vend.
 - e. Maintenance of law and order and good conduct in their vicinity
 - f. Ensuring no spurious liquor is sold
 - g. Ensuring no brand pushing to consumers
 - h. Ensuring consumers have choice of brands in their vend
 - i. Mandatory purchase of supply from L1 license holders in Delhi etc. and no direct purchase from manufacturers
 - j. Ensuring no underage person is sold alcohol and an ID check is conducted when necessary
 - k. Licensee will ensure no dry snacks or cooked food outlet gets opened right outside the shop which encourage people to drink and loiter around the shop itself.

The compliance of license parameters and maintenance of law and order in the vicinity of his vends shall be an important parameter to decide whether his zonal license would be renewed at the end of year.

- 7.11 Stringent penal action will be taken against the licensee if any of the license conditions is not complied with, including but not limited to immediate cancellation of the license of the particular vend with no reduction of license fees for the entire zone.
- 7.12 The licensee will ensure that the operation of L-7V Vend is totally computerized having facility of bar-code scanners. Billing shall only be through automatic decoding of bar codes through the scanners.
- 7.13 The Zonal licensee shall maintain appropriate records as specified by the Excise Department for retail vends in Form 2, Form 3 and Form 25.
- 7.14 The Licensee shall give to the Deputy Commissioner (Excise) a declaration in writing by the 8th day of every month certifying that he has declared all outstanding excise revenues and other dues recoverable from him. The Deputy Commissioner (Excise) or any Assistant Commissioner/Excise officer may refuse to issue any passes or permits to the licensee in the absence of such declaration or any sufficient reasons, to be recorded in writing, if he has reasons to believe that the Licensee has not, on demand paid any dues recoverable or dues

payable on account of undue pecuniary benefits obtained by the License holders due to furnishing of wrong information or/and suppressing the material information furnished to the Department at the time of initially applying for the License. The L-7Z & L-7V licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation or relief on account of such refusal. 145/c

- 7.15** The zonal licensee shall submit monthly statement as prescribed in Form 11, of sale of Indian and Foreign liquor separately by the 7th day of every following month.
- 7.16** The retail licenses shall be renewable subject to timely payment of license fee and compliance of all the rules and regulations.
- 7.17** No person to whom License has been granted shall be entitled to claim renewal thereof and no claim shall lie for damages or otherwise in consequence of any refusal to renew a License on the expiry of the period for which the same remains in force.
- 7.18** For implementation of the Excise Supply Chain Information Management System (ESCIMS), the standard operating procedures for barcoding shall be made available to all L-7Z & L-7V licensees. The licensee shall be required to procure, install and make necessary provisions for IT and non-IT infrastructure at the licensed premises for successful implementation of the Excise Supply Chain Information Management System.
- 7.19** The licensee must install CCTV Cameras at appropriate places with the minimum coverage of 50 meters in and around the store and archival period of minimum 30 days.
- 7.20** The L-7V licensee may be allowed to issue P-10/P-10E permits.
- 7.21** The retail licenses shall be renewable subject to timely payment of license fee and compliance of all the rules and regulations.
- 8. LICENSED PREMISES**
- 8.1** The Licensed premises shall have adequate storage facilities, proper Electrical Fittings and shall be duly insured against Fire and Natural Hazards.
- 8.2** The license premises shall not lie in a non-permissible area. In case, the license premises lies in a non-permissible area, the same may be considered with the prior approval of the Government.
- 9. PAYMENTS**
- 9.1** The Licensee shall make all the payments to the department in connection with the operation of his License through online mode (e-challan) or by bank draft drawn in favour of Deputy Commissioner (Excise), Government of NCT of Delhi.
- 9.2** .If a licensee defaults in paying the monthly advance license fee, either partially or fully, then he shall be liable to pay, on the sum due, a simple interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date next following the day on which such payment became due. Further, if the default continues beyond the 15th day of the month, then an additional penalty at the rate of 0.1% per day on the sum due till the date of actual payment shall be levied.
- 9.3** The Licensee shall not be entitled for any interest or any other relief or compensation on account of any delay in the payment of any amount due to him by the Government.
- 10. PROHIBITION**
- 10.1** In pursuance of the Directive Principles of the State Policy relating to prohibition as contained in Article 47 of the Constitution of India, the Government may issue orders and directions from

time to time and such orders and directions shall be binding on the Licensee and no compensation shall be payable on that account. 144/C

10.2 The Licensee shall inter-alia abide by the following prohibitory measures namely:


- i. The licensee shall display a notice board prominently in front of the licensed premises declaring that "**Drinking of Liquor is injurious to Health**".
- ii. The Licensee shall neither sell liquor to persons who are below the prescribed age nor shall employ any person under the age of 21 (twenty one) years or suffering from contagious disease.
- iii. The Licensee shall not advertise any liquor product or any products having similar nomenclature of a liquor brand in the electronic media, unless such advertisement conforms to the Programme Code and Advertisement Code as laid down in the Cable Television Network (Regulation) Act, 1995 (7 of 1995) and the rules made there under. However, in-Shop branding shall be permitted only as per the Delhi Excise Rules, 2010.
- iv. No person shall print or publish in any newspaper, book, booklet, leaflet or any other publication or otherwise display or distribute any advertisement or other material soliciting the use of or offering any liquor or intoxicating drug or any other product having nomenclature similar to a liquor brand.

11. FURNISHING OF INFORMATION

The Licensee shall be bound to furnish any information in connection with L-7Z/L-7V License truly and faithfully within the time prescribed by the Commissioner or the Deputy Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner or Excise Inspector. Any refusal to furnish the information, furnishing of false information or non-compliance of the orders will be regarded as breach of the Terms and Conditions of the License. Breach of Terms and conditions may also result in non-issue of Transport Permits or suspension/cancellation of License.

12. POWER TO SUSPEND OR CANCEL LICENSE AND FORFEITURE OF SECURITY

- 12.1 The Authority granting L-7Z/L-7V license may suspend or cancel the license as per provisions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and rules made there under.
 - 12.2 The Licensing Authority may order forfeiture of part or whole of Security Amount in case of breach of any of the Terms and Conditions of L-7Z/L-7V License.
 - 12.3 In case of a surrender of a retail license by a zonal licensee, the security deposit shall be forfeited and the zone will be re-tendered and the said licensee will also be prohibited from participating in any other bidding process for a period of two years.
13. The Terms & Conditions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 and all orders/directions issued there under shall be deemed to form an integral and inseparable part of the Terms and Conditions as if they were expressly set out in the Terms & Conditions for grant of L-7Z/L-7V license. Applicants are also hereby advised to access, read and understand the same before applying.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF L-7SP1 (SUPER PREMIUM RETAIL VEND) LICENSE
FOR THE YEAR 2021-22.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENSE IN FORM L-7SP1 FOR THE EXCISE YEAR 2021-22 FOR THE RETAIL SALE OF INDIAN AND FOREIGN LIQUOR EXCLUDING COUNTRY LIQUOR IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL TERRITORY OF DELHI FOR THE LICENSING PERIOD 2021-2022.

LICENSE in Form L-7SP1 for Super Premium Retail vend of Indian Liquor, Foreign Liquor in the National Capital Territory of Delhi shall be granted by the Government for the year 2021-2022 in accordance with the following terms and conditions:-

1. CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENSE

- 1.1** L-7SP1- Five Super Premium License shall be granted for operation of international quality premium retail vends which shall offer high-end walk-in experiences for consumers.
- 1.2** The five Super Premium licenses (L-7SP1) will be tendered separately as one group to one entity and these vends can be opened anywhere in the city except Airport Zone.
- 1.3** The licensees shall pay the license fee as determined through e-tender.
- 1.4** The proposed retail vend in the form of L-7SP1 shall comply with Rule 51(1) of the Delhi Excise Rules, 2010.
- 1.5** The winning entity for the e-tender of 5 L-7SP1 licenses shall tie-up with any one or more of the zonal operators (excluding Airport Zone) and convert one of their existing vends into a super-premium vend by arriving at a mutual agreement with the zone operator holding license in the form of L-7Z.
- 1.6** Super Premium Vends will be allowed to sell products only above MRP of Rs. 200/- for Beer and above Rs. 1000 Retail price for all other spirits including but not limited to Whiskey, Gin, Vodka, Brandy etc.
- 1.7** Super Premium Vends will need to stock at least 50 imported (BIO) liquor brands including wines (BECRS) etc. brands in the store.
- 1.8** The Super Premium Vends can dedicate upto 10% of their space to sell ancillary products such as Cigars, liquor chocolates etc., high-end art paintings, high value merchandise such as bottle openers, ice boxes, bar glasses etc.
- 1.9** The Super Premium Vends can setup a tasting room within the premise which will have to be an enclosed area, not visible from rest of the store. This room can only hold training and tasting sessions.
- 1.10** Super Premium Vends are permitted to have shop-in-shop concept for exclusive display of various brands in exclusive shelves, so that the customers can walk-in into the display for their selection of products.

1.11 All the other conditions applicable for L-7V vends would apply unless specifically mentioned as an exception in the above points.

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2. ELIGIBILITY TO HOLD LICENSE

2.1 Any entity or individual bidding for Super Premium Vends must have experience of operating high-quality liquor vends anywhere in India. At least one of these vends should be a walk-in experience store with 2,500 Sq Ft or above retail area and operational for at least one year.

2.2 Any entity or individual bidding for Super Premium Vends should have experience of retailing of over 50 BIO brands.

2.3 Joint Ventures are also eligible to apply. In case of a Joint Venture, at least one of the partner firms of the Joint Venture should have the required individual experience as detailed above.

2.4 The license fee may be increased on an annual basis as determined by the Government.

2.5 The proposed L-7SP1 retail vend in a zone should not be located within 100 (One Hundred only) meters from the following:-

- a. Major Educational Institutions (Middle and Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges and other Institutions of higher learning, recognized by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi or Govt. of India).
- b. Religious Places having pucca structure with a covered area of more than 400 (Four Hundred only) sq. ft.
- c. Hospitals with fifty beds and above.

2.6 No manufacturer or L-1 license holder will be allowed to bid for zonal license of retail vend in form L-7SP1 or vice versa. If retailers and manufacturers/wholesalers are common entities, there is possibility of formation of syndicates leading to overcharging and brand influencing/pushing by entering into exclusivity arrangements with certain brands at the cost of exclusion of others. The retail license holder shall not have any manufacturing facilities/distilleries/breweries/wineries anywhere in the country or abroad either directly or through any sister concerns/related entities. For this purpose, sister concerns/related entities shall mean that the entities should not have common proprietor or partners or directors. 2.7 The entity to participate in the tender for retail license/ vends should have net worth of at least Rs.6 crore, if the entity intends to participate in tender for one zone and net worth of at least Rs.12 crore, if the entity intends to participate in tender for more than one zone..

3. HOURS OF SALE AND DRY DAYS

3.1 Sale of Indian liquor and foreign liquor shall be allowed of Indian Liquor and foreign liquor shall be allowed **between 10 am and 11 pm only.**

3.2 The Government shall declare any day as dry day in accordance with Rule 52 of the Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 which maybe at par with the neighboring States. The L-7SP1 Licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation or relief due to any increase in the number of Dry Days or due to change in the hours of sale of Indian and Foreign liquor during the licensing year 2021-22.



Days or due to change in the hours of sale of Indian and Foreign liquor during the licensing year 2021-22.

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4. **ALLOTMENT OF THE SUPER PREMIUM VENDS:**

- 4.1 The reserve license fee for Super Premium (L-7SP1) vends shall be two and a half times of the Average reserve license fees of a vend in Delhi. Average reserve license fees of a vend in Delhi = Sum total of reserve price of all zones/ the number of vends excluding the five super premium outlets (844 outlets).
- 4.2 Allotment will be made through e-tender process with the reserve price as the base license fees. The winning entity for the e-tender of 5 L-7SP1 licenses shall tie-up with any one or more of the zonal licensee (excluding Airport Zone) holding license in the form of L-7Z and convert their existing vends into a super-premium vend by arriving at a mutual agreement with the zonal licensee holding license in the form of L-7Z.
- 4.3 The license fees for the first year will only be charged on a pro-rata basis from the scheduled date of commencement of business to the end of the fiscal year 2021-2022. For illustration, if there are 9 operative months left in the fiscal year after the scheduled date of commencement of business, the license fees will be payable only for 9 months calculated on pro-rata basis.
- 4.4 The license fee shall be paid by the licensee in accordance with the provisions of Rule 48, wherein a licensee shall, by the 7th of the month in which he begins his business under his license and thereafter by the 7th of every subsequent month, pay in advance one-twelfth of the annual license fee till the whole fee is paid. The 25% security deposited by the licensee shall be adjusted at close of the year. He may, however, at any time, pay the whole amount due if he so wishes.
- 4.5 If a licensee defaults in paying the monthly advance license fee, either partially or fully, then he shall be liable to pay, on the sum due, a simple interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date next following the day on which such payment became due. Further, if the default continues beyond the 15th day of the month, then an additional penalty at the rate of 0.1% per day on the sum due till the date of actual payment shall be levied. Further, if the licensee fails to pay all the dues (including interest and penalty) by the last day of the month then security deposit shall be forfeited and the license shall be cancelled and re-tendered. The licensee will also be blacklisted and prohibited from participating in any other tendering process for a period of two years.
- 4.6 The successful bidder of the zone licensee shall have to pay the pro-rata monthly fee for a zone as a whole, even if for any reason he chooses to set up less than the prescribed number of vends in his zone.
- 4.7 L-7SP1 Super Premium outlets will get a time of 6 months from the date of issue of L-7SP1 license to commence business in all their shops. This scheduled date of commencement will be non-negotiable and if any vend is unable to start operations by then, they will have to still pay the monthly license fee for the entire 5 L-7SP1 licenses.
- 4.8 For participation in the bid, the applicant has to pay EMD of Rs 15 crore. This EMD will be refunded if the applicant does not win the bid. If the applicant does not accept the license after winning the bid within the stipulated time frame, the EMD amount shall stand forfeited.
- 4.9 The successful bidder shall provide a security deposit to match 25% of the winning bid amount within one week of the date of issue of Letter of Offer, after adjusting the initial EMD. If a successful bidder fails to pay the 25% security deposit, the EMD shall stand forfeited. The bidder will also be blacklisted and prohibited from participating in any other bidding process for a period of two years. In case, the security deposit is less than the EMD, then the remaining amount will be adjusted towards the payment of license fee.
- 4.10 If the licensee is found being engaged in major malpractices, its license will be cancelled immediately and re-tendered thereafter.



5. PROCEDURE TO APPLY

- 5.1 The applicant applying for grant of L-7SP1 License shall participate in e-tender process by paying a non-refundable participation fee of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only).
- 5.2 The applicant shall be required to submit the following documents along with the application:-
- An Affidavit with regard to qualifications for grant of license as prescribed under Section 13 of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009
 - A copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) along with copies of the Income Tax Returns filed by the applicant for the assessment years 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21.
- 5.3 The information as required for this purpose in the application form shall be furnished with complete details truly and faithfully as to enable processing the applications for grant of L-7SP1 license. The applicants shall not be entitled to any relief for compensation on account of delay in the finalization of case for the grant of L-7SP1 License.

6. OTHER CONDITIONS FOR LICENSES

- 6.1 After the completion of the tendering process, the L-7SP1 licensees will be given two weeks' time to submit their inputs regarding the MRP to the Excise Commissioner. The Excise Commissioner will fix MRP for each product after taking into account the inputs from L-7Z and L-7SP1 licensees and the price of the product in the neighbouring States i.e. Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab and Rajasthan. The Excise Commissioner will also provide an opportunity of being heard to each L-7Z and L-7SP1 licensee as prescribed in Rule 54. Similar process will be followed at the time of introduction of new brands during the course of the year. The licensee is free to give concession, rebate or discount on the MRP.
- 6.2 L-7SP1 licensees are eligible for retail sale of Indian liquor and Foreign liquor to individuals and to all license holders of Hotels, Clubs, Restaurants, Permit Holders etc. in form of L-15, L-16, L-17, L-19, L-20, L-21, L-28, L-29, L-38, P-10, P-10E and other licenses/permits as permitted by the Excise Commissioner.
- 6.3 The L-7SP1 Licensee shall procure Indian and Foreign liquor from L-1 Licensee only through ESCIMS.
- 6.4 Every L-7SP1 license shall be granted subject to the conditions that the Licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009, the Rules framed there under, terms and conditions for grant of L-7SP1 License and orders issued by the Excise Commissioner from time to time.
- 6.5 The L-7SP1 retail vends can be opened in any of the markets, malls, commercial roads/areas, local shopping complexes (LSCs) etc. as long as the standard rules and regulations of opening a new vend in Delhi is followed which includes restrictions on opening vends within a specified distance of schools, religious institutions etc.
- 6.6 Every vend shall provide a walk-in experience and should be designed accordingly. To illustrate, customers will not be allowed to crowd outside a vend or in the pavement and buy through the counter. Each customer shall be given access inside the vend and the entire selection and sale process is to be completed within the vend premise. The vend shall have closed glass doors.

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- 6.7 Vends will need to be air conditioned and well lit.
- 6.8 Each vend will have CCTV cameras installed inside and outside the shop and the recording shall be maintained minimum for a period of one month.
- 6.9 Adequate security arrangements shall be made by the licensee in and around each vend.
- 6.10 Licensee shall be responsible for maintenance of law and order around their vend. In case the vend causes nuisance in the neighbourhood and complaint is received by the Government, the license of that particular vend may be cancelled. However, the license fees for the zone will remain the same.
- 6.11 The licensees will have to ensure that all the terms and conditions of the license including but not limited to following:
- a. Timely payment of fees
 - b. Ensuring walk-in retail experience
 - c. No major complaints from the nearby community against the shop.
 - d. Neighborhood should not experience any disturbance due to the vend.
 - e. Maintenance of law and order and good conduct in their vicinity
 - f. Ensuring no spurious liquor is sold
 - g. Ensuring no brand pushing to consumers
 - h. Ensuring consumers have choice of brands in their vend
 - i. Mandatory purchase of supply from L-1 license holders in Delhi etc. and no direct purchase from manufacturers
 - j. Ensuring no underage person is sold alcohol and an ID check is conducted when necessary
 - k. Licensee will ensure no dry snacks or cooked food outlet gets opened right outside the shop which encourage people to drink and loiter around the shop itself.
- The compliance of license parameters and maintenance of law and order in the vicinity of his vends shall be an important parameter to decide whether his zonal license would be renewed at the end of year.
- 6.12 Stringent penal action will be taken against the licensee if any of the license conditions is not complied with, including but not limited to immediate cancellation of the license of the particular vend with no reduction of license fees for the entire zone.
- 6.13 The licensee will ensure that the operation of L-7SP1 Vend is totally computerized having facility of bar-code scanners. Billing shall only be through automatic decoding of bar codes through the scanners.
- 6.14 The L-7SP1 licensee shall maintain appropriate records as specified by the Excise Department for retail vends in Form 2, Form 3 and Form 25.
- 6.15 The Licensee shall give to the Deputy Commissioner (Excise) a declaration in writing by the 8th day of every month certifying that he has declared all outstanding excise revenues and other dues recoverable from him. The Deputy Commissioner (Excise) or any Assistant Commissioner/Excise officer may refuse to issue any passes or permits to the licensee in the absence of such declaration or any sufficient reasons, to be recorded in writing, if he has reasons to believe that the Licensee has not, on demand paid any dues recoverable or dues payable on account of undue pecuniary benefits obtained by the License holders due to furnishing of wrong information or/and suppressing the material information furnished to the Department at the time of initially applying for the License. The L-7SP1 licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation or relief on account of such refusal.
- 6.16 The L-7SP1 licensee shall submit monthly statement as prescribed in Form 11, of sale of Indian and Foreign liquor separately by the 7th day of every following month.

6.17 The retail licenses shall be renewable subject to timely payment of license fee and compliance of all the rules and regulations.

6.18 No person to whom License has been granted shall be entitled to claim renewal thereof and no claim shall lie for damages or otherwise in consequence of any refusal to renew a License on the expiry of the period for which the same remains in force.

6.19 For implementation of the Excise Supply Chain Information Management System (ESCIMS), the standard operating procedures for barcoding shall be made available to all L-7SP1 licensees. The licensee shall be required to procure, install and make necessary provisions for IT and non-IT infrastructure at the licensed premises for successful implementation of the Excise Supply Chain Information Management System.

6.20 The licensee must install CCTV Cameras at appropriate places with the minimum coverage of 50 meters in and around the store and archival period of minimum 30 days.

6.21 The L-7SP1 licensee may be allowed to issue P-10 permits.

6.22 The retail licenses shall be renewable subject to timely payment of license fee and compliance of all the rules and regulations

7. LICÈNSED PREMISES

7.1 The Licensed premises shall have adequate storage facilities, proper Electrical Fittings and shall be duly insured against Fire and Natural Hazards.

7.2 The license premises shall not lie in a non-permissible area. In case, the license premises falls in a non-permissible area, the same may be considered with the prior approval of the Government.

8. PAYMENTS

8.1 The Licensee shall make all the payments to the department in connection with the operation of his License through online mode (e-challan) or by bank draft drawn in favour of Deputy Commissioner (Excise), Government of NCT of Delhi.

8.2 The Licensee shall pay simple interest @12% p.a. from the date on which any payment recoverable from him, under Section 30 of the Delhi Excise Act 2009, becomes due until the date such payment is actually made of such amount recovered. However, if a licensee defaults in paying the monthly advance license fee, either partially or fully, then he shall be liable to pay, on the sum due, a simple interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date next following the day on which such payment became due. Further, if the default continues beyond the 15th day of the month, then an additional penalty at the rate of 0.1% per day on the sum due till the date of actual payment shall be levied

8.3 The Licensee shall not be entitled for any interest or any other relief or compensation on account of any delay in the payment of any amount due to him by the Government.

9. PROHIBITION

9.1 In pursuance of the Directive Principles of the State Policy relating to prohibition as contained in Article 47 of the Constitution of India, the Government may issue orders and directions from time to time and such orders and directions shall be binding on the Licensee and no compensation shall be payable on that account.

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9.2 The Licensee shall inter-alia abide by the following prohibitory measures namely:


- i. The licensee shall display a notice board prominently in front of the licensed premises declaring that "Drinking of Liquor is injurious to Health".
- ii. The Licensee shall neither sell liquor to persons who are below the prescribed age nor shall employ any person under the age of 21(twenty one) years or suffering from contagious disease.
- iii. The Licensee shall not advertise any liquor product or any products having similar nomenclature of a liquor brand in the electronic media, unless such advertisement conforms to the Programme Code and Advertisement Code as laid down in the Cable Television Network (Regulation) Act, 1995 (7 of 1995) and the rules made there under. However, in-Shop branding shall be permitted only as per the Delhi Excise Rules, 2010.
- iv. No person shall print or publish in any newspaper, book, booklet, leaflet or any other publication or otherwise display or distribute any advertisement or other material soliciting the use of or offering any liquor or intoxicating drug or any other product having nomenclature similar to a liquor brand.

10. FURNISHING OF INFORMATION

The Licensee shall be bound to furnish any information in connection with L-7SP1 License truly and faithfully within the time prescribed by the Commissioner or the Deputy Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner or Excise Inspector. Any refusal to furnish the information, furnishing of false information or non-compliance of the orders will be regarded as breach of the Terms and Conditions of the License. Breach of Terms and conditions may also result in non-issue of Transport Permits or suspension/cancellation of License.

11. POWER TO SUSPEND OR CANCEL LICENSE AND FORFEITURE OF SECURITY

- 11.1 The Authority granting L-7SP1 license may suspend or cancel the license as per provisions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and rules made thereunder.
- 11.2 The Licensing Authority may order forfeiture of part or whole of Security Amount in case of breach of any of the Terms and Conditions of L-7SP1 License.
- 11.3 In case of a surrender of a retail license by a L-7SP1 licensee, the security deposit shall be forfeited and the zone will be re-tendered and the said licensee will also be prohibited from participating in any other bidding process for a period of two years.
12. The Terms & Conditions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 and all orders/directions issued there under shall be deemed to form an integral and inseparable part of the Terms and Conditions as if they were expressly set out in the Terms & Conditions for grant of L-7SP1 license. Applicants are also hereby advised to access, read and understand the same before applying.
